

WE ARE BACK (since the 27th of May) – Finally! We hope all of you got well through the lockdown and you are all in good health.

We are open again and climbing & bouldering is possible again. However we are required to implement some rules that make it possible for YOU to go climbing & bouldering even during COVID-19 times.

By entering the climbing hall CUBE Trier you agree to the following rules to protect yourself and others. If someone does not comply with these rules they are unfortunately barred from entering.

**>> Please read these rules carefully BEFORE your first visit!**

**Mask required during:**

- Check-In & Check-Out
- Moving through the building (to the toilets, to the Bistro, to the climbing wall etc.)

**Exception:** the actively climbing teams and the boulderers on the wall

**Restrictions:**

- Not more than 65 people in the hall at any time.
- Due to this spectators are currently not allowed. Entrance only for paying climbers.
- We have to insist that you check-out at the pay desk when leaving.
- If the maximum number of people in the hall is reached, we will have to limit the climbing time for everyone to a maximum of 3 hours.

### CHECK-IN:

- Please inform yourself at [www.cube-trier.de](http://www.cube-trier.de) if we have free capacities.
- Please only use the marked walkways.
- Please keep your distance. Minimum 1,50 meters!
- Please put on your mask before entering the building!
- Please bring your ID\*

### Hygiene & Conduct in the hall

- Please only visit if you feel fit & healthy!
- Disinfect your hand when entering the hall
- Thorough hand washing BEFORE and AFTER climbing / bouldering / belaying
- Adhere to sneeze etiquette
- Minimum distance of 1,50 m
- Please come dressed ready for climbing, the locker rooms are currently closed.
- Use Liquid-Chalk. It works as a disinfectant due to its alcohol level.

### Climbing Indoor:

The climbing walls are divided into compartments via markings on the floor Only one climbing team (2 people) per compartment. The compartments are big enough to allow free movement . Please leave enough space to the people in the next compartment, at least 1,50 meters!

There are no mask requirements for the climbing teams within the compartments.

### Climbing Outdoor / Garden:

Outside everyone must make sure for themselves that distances are kept. Climbers have to decide for themselves if they want to wear a mask. Endangering behaviour won't be tolerated.

### **Bouldering Indoor:**

Not more than 10 people in the bouldering area at any given time.

The entering of the bouldering area is only permitted after calling at the pay desk.

### **Bouldering Outdoor:**

The facility is closed for 2020.

### **Groups:**

Groups are only allowed if they are in accordance with the Verordnungen zu COVID-19 of the Landesregierung. We currently offer group climbing events with modified terms.

### **Children:**

- Children under 8 years are temporarily not permitted.
- Birthday parties are temporarily not offered.

### **Children Birthday Parties**

- Currently offered for up to 8 children + one accompanying adult

### **Group Climbing Events with coach**

- Currently offered, with an upper limit of 9 people

### **Belaying Courses**

- Currently offered, with an upper limit of 6 people
